Dear Mr. Thorne:

In relation with the above mentioned export license application, I am pleased to inform you that the Spanish Junta de Energía Nuclear confirms the following:

- a) The transfer of the material, as identified on the license application will be subject to all of the terms and conditions of the Agreement of Cooperation, which entered into force on June 28, 1974, as amended, concerning civil use of atomic energy between the Government of the United States and the Government of Spain.
- b) The intermediate and the ultimate consignees, as identified on the application, are authorized by the Spanish Government to receive and possess the material.
- c) All peaceful nuclear activities in Spain are subject to the IAEA safeguards. In the unlikely event that this situation is to change during the time the proposed shipments covered by the subject application are pending, the Government of Spain will consult with the Government of the United States 90 days in advance.
