Gentlemen:

Because of recent changes in personnel and operations for our office, we wish to amend the above referenced license which we maintain for nuclear density testing gauges for our materials inspection services. Enclosed with this letter, please find an amended application form which we have completed for the changes we propose.

The basic changes that we are requesting be made in our existing license are as follows.

- 1) Our Radiation Safety Officer has been changed to Robert T. Stickney as indicated in the amended application.
- 2) We have established a branch testing office in Dayton, Ohio, and wish to store licensed material at our location there. Under Item 10 on the license, we wish to have that amended to read that the "licensed material shall be used only at 11306 Tamarco Drive, Cincinnati, Ohio 45242; 2718 Linden Avenue, Dayton, Ohio 45203; and at temporary jobsites of the licensee throughout the states of Ohio, Indiana, Kentucky, and West Virginia.
- 3) Under Item 12 of the current license is the stipulation that all users of the licensed material should attend the Device Manufacturer's Training Course for gauge users. Because of the logistical problems of having all our personnel attend the manufacturer's course, we wish to amend the license so that attendance of a similar course presented by ATEC personnel would also be acceptable. We have at least two (2) individuals within our company (Mr. Bill Ochs in our Columbia, 15601

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Maryland office, and Mr. Scott Greer in our Salisbury Engineering Subsidiary in Griffith, Indiana) who have been approved by the NRC to provide the necessary training. We would like to have the license state that all user personnel should have a training course presented by qualified ATEC personnel who have been approved by the NRC, or the manufacturer's course.
