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This letter is to serve as a written confirmation of our telephone conversation of 3/27/85.

The current climate for the practice of private medicine in my area is changing rapidly and I do not feel that I can continue to practice under the stringent regulatory requirements for the use of Technetium.

I appreciate the help that you have offered during and since your inspection, but in as much as this speciality is a "high overhead" speciality I believe I should discontinue my current license.

I do not know the requirements regarding disposition of sealed sources and would welcome your recommendations regarding this, as well as any other procedural steps to follow in implementing this decision. My current lease expires on June 1st, if that sounds like a reasonable date to discontinue operations.

In that I enjoy the practice of nuclear medicine and have been doing so for the past 22 years, I hope that our parting company is temporary and that I can return to this some day in some form.
