Dear Sir or Madam:

This letter shall serve as formal notice that the consolidation between University Hospital, Inc. (doing business as Boston University Medical Center Hospital), Boston City Hospital, and Boston Specialty and Rehabilitation Hospital the later two hospitals being medical facilities owned and operated by the City of Boston's Department of Health and Hospitals) was completed on July 1st, 1996.

As a result of the consolidation a new hospital - Boston Medical Center - has been created to provide the inpatient, outpatient, emergency and other health care services formerly provided by the three hospitals. In addition, the City of Boston has created a new Public Health Commission to provide and supervise public health services formerly provided by the City through its hospitals.

The new hospital - Boston Medical Center - will remain a member of Boston University Medical Center (consisting of the hospital, the Boston University Schools of Medicine, Public Health, and Graduate School of Dentistry).

Gentlemen:

This is to inform you of a change relating to the Boston University Medical Center license no. 20-02215-01. Effective July 1, 1996, we expect the following to change:

- 1) The Director of Boston University Medical Center, Richard Egdahl, M.D. will retire. The Director's position will now be called Medical Campus Provost. The Medical Campus Provost will be Aram Chobanian, M.D., who will continue as Dean of Boston University School of Medicine.
- 2) The Medical Center will still consist of the Schools of Medicine, Dentistry and its university affiliated hospital.
- 3) Boston University Medical Center Hospital as part of Boston University Medical Center will merge with Boston City Hospital, which has its own NRC specific license 20-00275-08. The new entity will be called Boston Medical Center, Inc. This new hospital will continue as part of Boston University Medical Center. Enclosed is correspondence from executive management of both hospitals acknowledging the merger.
- 4) The Boston University Medical Center license will continue with its current program. The Radiation Safety Officer will continue to be Victor Evdokimoff, CHP and the Chairman will continue to be Richard Cohen, M.D. The Boston City Hospital Radioisotope Safety Program will become on July 1<sup>st</sup> the Boston University Medical Center Radioisotope Program.
- 5) The Boston University Medical Center Radioisotope Committee membership will reflect former Boston City Hospital radioisotope users. The Committee will address any issues that need to be changed to produce a unified hospital program under its broad medical license.

When the merger is official, we will submit an amendment to change the Boston University Medical Center License. Should you desire further information, please do not hesitate to contact me or the Radiation Safety Officer, Victor Evdokimoff at (617) 638-7052.

Dear Friend:

As you may know, the Boston University Medical Center Hospital ("BUMCH") and the City of Boston are in the final stages of completing the consolidation of BUMCH, Boston City Hospital and Boston Specialty Rehabilitation Hospital. Upon final approval of the City Council and the BUMCH governing bodies, the consolidation will take place on July 1, 1996. The new consolidated entity will be known as the Boston Medical Center Corporation.

The Boston Medical Center Corporation ("BMCC") will be organized under Massachusetts law as a charitable corporation and will be exempt from both state and federal taxation. BUMCH will merge into BMCC through a statutory merger and the license beds and operations of BCH and BSRH will be transferred to BMCC under special legislation passed last year.

It is our expectation that BSRH will continue to operate at its present Mattapan site for some period after July 1, 1996; the BSRH operations will be moved to the downtown campus at a future date. In the meantime, the facilities of the former BUMCH and BCH will be operated under a single hospital license.

The City administration and the staffs of BCH and BUMCH are very enthusiastic about the prospects of the Boston Medical Center Corporation. We believe that this coming together of the traditions and histories of these fine institutions is the best alternative for these entities and is in the best interests of the people of Boston. We look forward to a bright future for our combined facilities.
