Dear Mr. Thomas:

In accordance with the stipulations in your letters of June 11, 1984 and July 10, 1984 to this facility, the Emergency Plan for the WSU TRIGA reactor was implemented on January 1, 1985.

In March of 1985 we decided that including the emergency plan implementing procedures in our standard procedures manual as specified by Appendix C of our emergency plan was not a very satisfactory arrangement. Accordingly, a separate binder entitled "WSU Emergency Plan and Implementing Procedures" was set up. In addition, the implementing procedures were reorganized into sections for ease of use during an emergency. The section of the revised implementing procedures manual are as follows:


