Certification of Permanently Defueled Condition

By letter dated January 27, 1993, Portland General Electric (PGE) submitted License Change Application (LCA) 229, requesting modification to the Trojan Nuclear Plant Facility Operating License to a "Possession Only License". The requested amendment is to become effective upon Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) approval of the amendment, and upon written certification from PGE to the NRC that the reactor fuel has been permanently off-loaded from the reactor vessel and placed in the spent fuel pool. This letter certifies that the reactor fuel has been permanently removed from the reactor vessel at Trojan and has been placed in the spent fuel pool. The reactor core off-load was completed, thus placing the reactor in the permanently defueled and shutdown condition, January 27, 1993.
