We are enclosing the proposal from Chem-Nuclear Systems, Inc. to clean up the hazardous waste material at the Metcoa plant site in Pulaski, Pa., for your review and approval as to the methods and procedures.

We are also attempting to get a bid from Hittman International of Maryland and also U.S. Ecology of Louisville, Kentucky.

An aerial Radiological company, E.G.G. of Los Vegas, Nevada was to perform a survey of the Metcoa site sometime between April 5th and April 25th, 1985. Mark Reveria of this company contacted me for specific information concerning the location of the site. May we have the results of this survey?

Is it possible for a tenant or purchaser of the plant to begin moving into the site while the clean-up is in progress?

Regarding The Pesses Company License:

1. Was any type of Bond required of The Pesses Company at the time the license was granted? If so, may we have the name of the company?
2. Item 13 and 14 of the License refers to statements, representations, and procedures contained in applications dated July 23, 1975 and January 13, 1978 and letters dated August 26, 1975, September 8th and September 19, 1975 and May 23, 1978. May we have copies of this information?

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
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What are the procedures and time frame for getting a final site survey and statement which can be given to a new purchaser?
