The tabletop will begin at 8:30 a.m. and end at approximately 4:30 p.m. The purpose of the tabletop is to ensure that NRC and the United States Enrichment Corporation (USEC) are prepared to respond to an incident at a GDP in a complementary, consistent, and effective manner. This exercise will involve participants from the Portsmouth and Paducah GDPs, USEC, and NRC (including the Office for Analysis and Evaluation of Operational Data, the Office of Nuclear Materials Safety and Safeguards, and NRC Region III). In addition, DOE is invited to provide a historical perspective of emergency response.
