COMMENTS:

I approve the final rule and its inclusion of the two-man requirement. However, the NRC needs to gain a better understanding of the relationship between specific requirements and their impact on safety. The intended safety benefits from the two-man rule may be based more on belief at this time, than on data. The staff should develop a means to measure the impact on safety of the two-man requirement, and, if possible, distinguish these impacts from impacts resulting from other related requirements, including upgrades in equipment, and increased training and certification requirements.
