Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. 552, the Government Accountability Project (GAP) requests copies of any and all agency records and information, including but not limited to notes, letters, memoranda, drafts, minutes, diaries, logs, calendars, tapes, transcripts, summaries, interview reports, procedures, instructions, engineering analyses, drawings, files, graphs, charts, maps, photographs, agreements, handwritten notes, studies, data sheets, notebooks, books, telephone messages, computations, voice or video recordings, and any other data compilations, interim reports, status reports, final reports, and any and all other records relevant to or generated in connection with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Region IV audit at the Wolf Creek Generating Station of several on site Kansas Gas and Electric offices. This request includes but is not limited to the audit of the personnel and security offices of KG&E on and around August 30, 1984, as well as any and all records relevant to and/or generated in connection with this Freedom of Information Request.


