Dear Mr. Norelius,

This letter is in response to your Notice of Violation dated October 8, 1992. Mr. Robert Friessen, the facility Radiation Safety Officer, has responded to the violations in a letter dated November 16, 1992.

You also requested that we describe how MPI management will assure that responsible personnel understand our survey and decontamination procedures and the significance of employing both efficiently.

In addition to the training described in my letter dated July 14, 1992, authorized users will be instructed a minimum of 5 days per month for three months by designees of my department. These individuals will provide guidance and instruction during the day to day course of business in the supervision and maintenance of the facility radiation safety program. Special assignments will be given to shift supervisors to enhance their understanding of various aspects of the program, and will be reviewed by regulatory or management personnel. Examples of these special assignments are to evaluate trends in routine survey results, and possible preventative measures; or to develop and implement annual refresher training program for employees.

At the end of this three month period, the facility will be re-evaluated, and recommendations will be made regarding the continuation of training.
