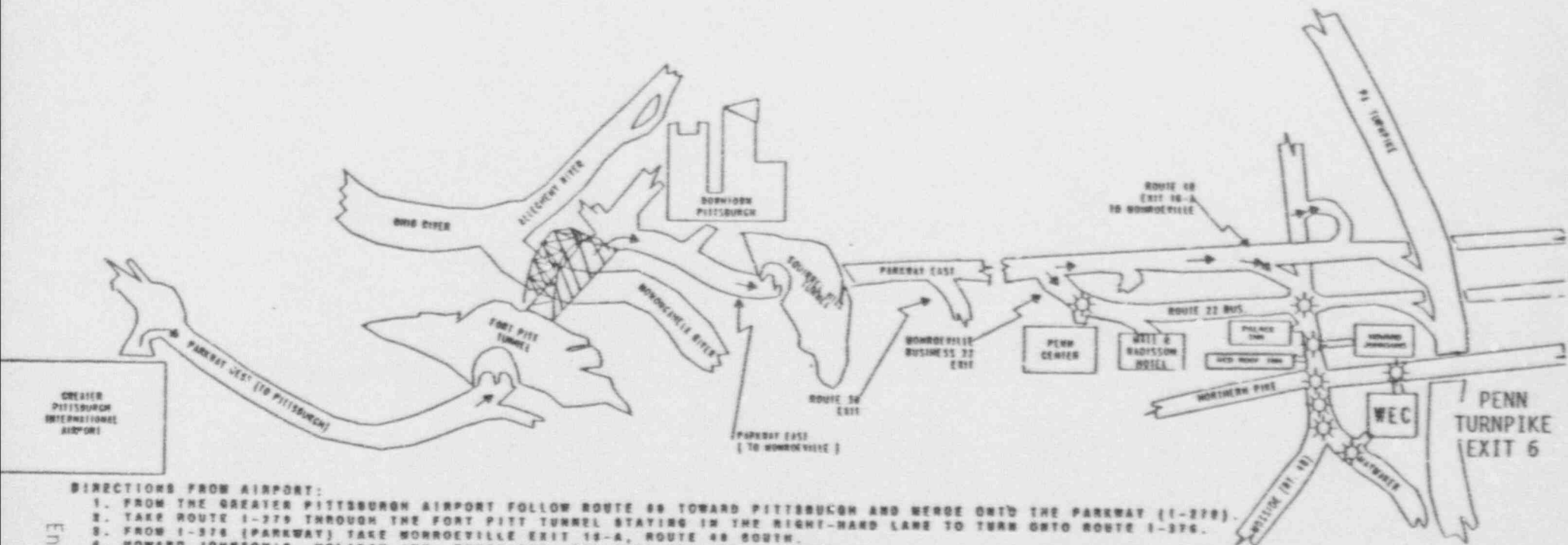

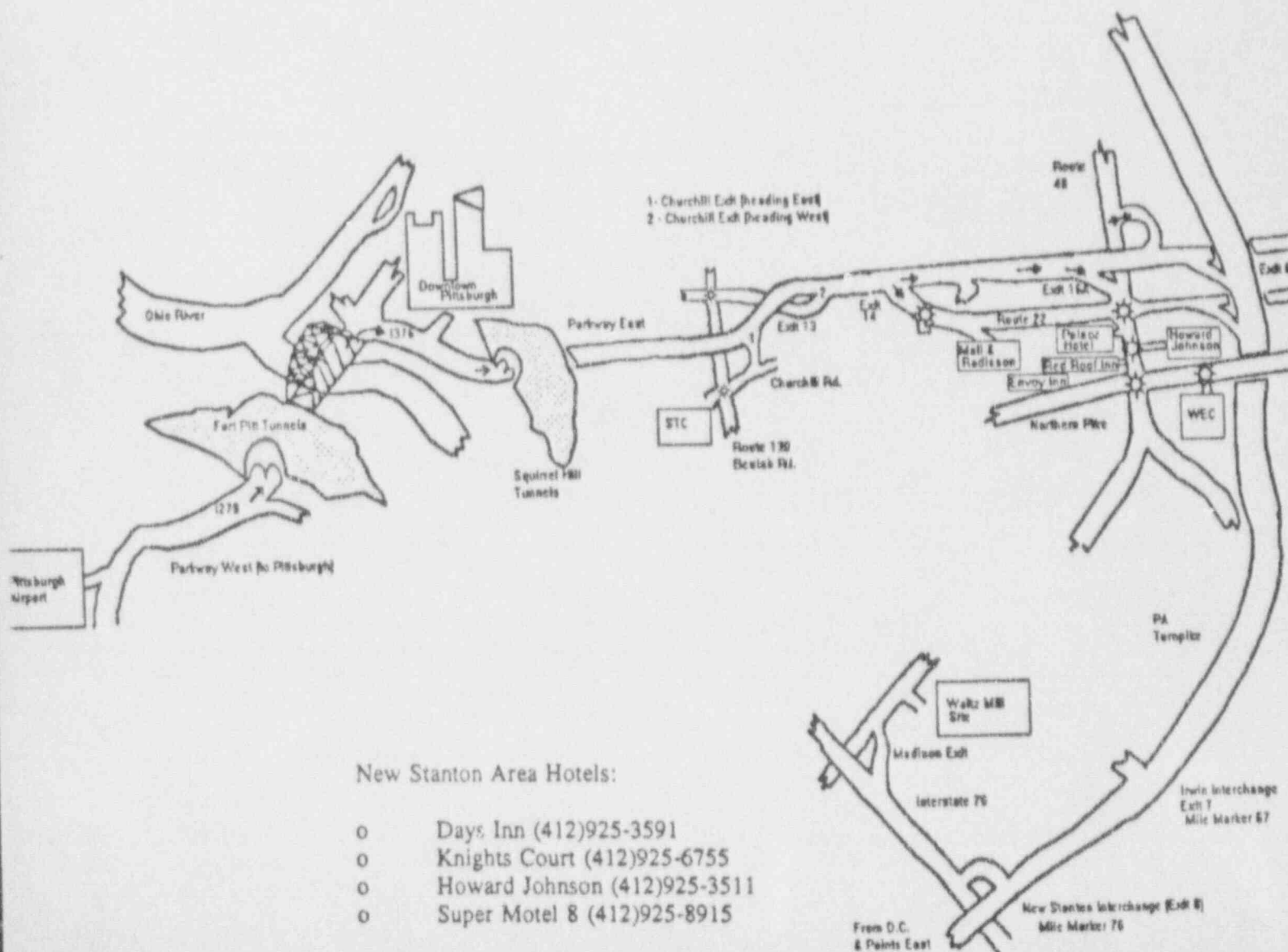
DIRECTIONS FROM AIRPORT:

1. FROM THE GREATER PITTSBURGH AIRPORT FOLLOW ROUTE 48 TOWARD PITTSBURGH AND MERGE ONTO THE PARKWAY (I-276).
2. TAKE ROUTE 1-276 THROUGH THE FORT PITT TUNNEL STAYING IN THE RIGHT-HAND LANE TO TURN ONTO ROUTE 1-276.
3. FROM 1-276 (PARKWAY) TAKE MONROEVILLE EXIT 18-A, ROUTE 48 SOUTH.
4. HOWARD JOHNSONS, HOLIDAY INN, ENVOY INN, RED ROOF INN ARE ON ROUTE 48.
5. FOR THE RADISSON, TURN RIGHT AT FIRST TRAFFIC LIGHT ON ROUTE 48, ONTO W. PENN HIGHWAY (BUSINESS ROUTE 22).
6. KEEP TO THE LEFT THRU-LANE AND TURN LEFT AFTER ABOUT 7 LIGHTS ONE LIGHT AFTER THE ZAYNE STORE'S LIGHT OR USE THE MALL ENTRANCE ON THE RIGHT ABOUT 1/2 MILE FURTHER DOWN.

To Westinghouse Waltz Mill Site

Allow approximately 1 hour forty-five minutes travel time (non rush hour) from the airport.

- From the airport, take Route 60 SOUTH to "PITTSBURGH"
- Route 60 becomes INTERSTATE 279. Continue going straight (East) to Pittsburgh. You will go through the Fort Pitt Tunnels.
- As you leave the FORT PITT TUNNELS, "279" becomes "376." When approaching the end of the bridge, watch for the RIGHT HAND EXIT for "376 EAST-MONROEVILLE."
- Follow Parkway East (I-376) to the Pennsylvania Turnpike. Head East two exits to the New Stanton Interchange (Exit 8).
- From New Stanton, take I-70 West for about three miles and turn off at Madison Exit. Follow Company signs to site.
- Enter Gate A.
