Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Messrs. C. Stearns and R. McClintock of this office on July 28, 1976 of activities authorized by NRC License No. 29-15364-01 and to the discussions of our findings held by Messrs. Stearns and McClintock with yourself and Mr. J. Masefield at the conclusion of the inspection, and to a subsequent telephone discussion between Mr. McClintock and Mr. Masefield on August 2, 1976.

The inspection was limited to an examination of the radiological safety control procedures implemented following the discovery of contamination from one or more of your cobalt-60 sources, as reported in your July 20, 1976 letter to this office. The inspection consisted of selected examinations of representative records, interviews with personnel, observations and measurements made by the inspector.

Our inspector also verified the steps you had taken to correct the item of noncompliance brought to your attention in a letter dated November 4, 1975. We have no further questions regarding your action at this time.

In addition, our inspector examined those activities conducted under your license relating to the subject covered in your letter to this office dated July 20, 1976. From the discussions conducted during the inspection, it is our understanding that you plan to submit a complete report covering this matter as required by 10 CFR 20.405(a). If our understanding is incorrect, please inform us immediately.


Within the scope of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were observed.
