Dear Dr. Mallett:

Amendment No. 02 of USNRC license 24-00063-11 authorizes Washington University Medical Center (St. Louis, MO.) to have a Gammacell-40 self-shielded irradiator at two different locations in order to achieve a relocation of the unit from 216 S. Kingshighway to 4939 Audubon Avenue. The final step of the transfer procedure authorized by you is for the licensee to notify the USNRC of the move and to request that the address of use prior to the move (216 S. Kingshighway) be deleted from the license.

The irradiator was re-located Wednesday, May 22, 1985 from the basement of the Jewish Hospital Kingshighway Building, 216 S. Kingshighway, to the basement of the Clinical Sciences Building. The transfer was supervised by a representative from the firm that manufactured the irradiator, Atomic Energy of Canada, Ltd., Ottawa, Canada, in addition to licensee personnel. The re-location was achieved without incident. A radiation survey conducted by me after the move yielded radiation levels consistent with those prior to the move. A majority of the institutional safety committee, the Radiation Safety Committee, reviewed the survey and authorized the unit to be put back into service the afternoon of May 24, 1985.

Records of the transfer, the radiation surveys, the committee actions and other related matters will be maintained by the Division of Radiation Safety for inspection by representatives of the USNRC.

It is my understanding that this notification completes the requirements associated with Amendment No. 02 and that an additional fee is not required. If I am in error please inform me and a check in the amount of \$120.00 will be forwarded to the USNRC.
