Gentlemen:

This is further to my letters of December 6, 1976 and January 12, 1977, and to our meeting in your offices on March 25, 1977.

As a result of the aforementioned meeting, we concur with your consultant's estimate of 400 rem as the overexposure dose to Subject B as referred to in your Inspection Report 74-01.

Our control program will be regulated to limit this individual's exposure below 1.25 rem per quarter to prevent future non-compliance. Specific steps will include:

1. Alerting appropriate key personnel, as well as the individual, that the individual's quarterly dose will not exceed 1.25 rem per quarter.
2. A weekly review of pocket dosimeter totals by the individual and either the RPO or his assistant.
3. A monthly review of film badge results by the RPO or his assistant.
4. Possible reassignment of the individual to non-radiation work when his quarterly allowed dose is being approached.

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
