Subject: Inspection 030-08985/77-01

In response to your letter of May 17, 1977, the following actions have been taken with reference to items noted in Appendix A.

Item A: Both areas have been posted with appropriate signs. Higher than normal dose rates were present in both areas because of storage of radioactive wastes nearby. To prevent recurrence, and to return the areas to normal, the wastes are being disposed of. Although the disposal schedule is dependent upon the nuclear waste company contracted with by us, it is our expectation that all accumulated waste still on hand will be removed from our premises by the end of June.


Item B: It is our understanding that the deficiency noted centered about a correlation between film badge reporting periods, and accumulated doses and quarterly cutoff periods as recorded on Form NRC 5.

Records referred to have been corrected to reflect cutoff dates and accumulated doses, if any, per the year-end film badge report. To prevent recurrence of this deficiency, quarterly entries on Form NRC 5 will also be in accordance with film badge reporting periods.

We will inform you periodically on our progress related to waste disposal. Dr. Glenn was to determine whether any advice or other guidance could be provided to us in this matter, and we await his reply.
