This is in further response to your letter dated November 26, 1984, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, copies of any documents subsequent to 1980 describing the scope of work and results from projects completed, or in the process of being conducted or planned, by Westinghouse Electric Corporation or the Nuclear Regulatory Commission relating to tests or analyses of steam generator tube degradation in pressurized water reactors.
