Requests forwarded deal with Pub L 97-425, 96 STAT 2201 et seq.

Requests as follows:

1. Any and all information concerning, adopted or approved, methods of pro-rating costs to generators of high level nuclear waste pursuant to Nuclear Waste Policy Act " Pub L 97-425, 96 STAT 2201 et seq;
2. Any and all information regarding estimates of costs related to the development and operation of high level repositories, and what will the cost relating therein be assessed to commercial nuclear facilities using the repository.
3. Any and all information concerning the contract requirements needed for the inclusion of a Commercial Nuclear Generating Station into the Nuclear Waste Fund. Further, all documents and records regarding what is entailed in the advance contract requirement.

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

6. Any further information not specifically named above that the department/commission feels would be helpful in determining the cost and requirements for the usage of the national repository for nuclear waste.
