Thank you for meeting with me last month. The session was very informative. Please find enclosed a revised version of our current AIC detector license amendment. Per our discussion Hochiki America has decided to combine the AIC and new AIE type detectors in to one application amendment submittal. Thus we have prepared an amendment to our license for the AI_ SERIES detector. This new amendment request shall take the place of our August 22, 1995 submittal. As we discussed the chamber technology used in both types of detectors are the same. Of course there are minor dimensional differences due to the cosmetic differences in the two types. These differences have been identified in our enclosure A20. Additionally we have included an Enclosure Index in order to simplify your review. This new submittal also incorporates the comments made by you in your letter dated June 3, 1996.
