### FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT REQUEST

Dear Mr. Felton:

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. 522, as amended, the Nuclear Information and Resource Service requests the following documents regarding the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant on behalf of the San Luis Obispo Mothers for Peace. Please consider "documents" to include reports, studies, test results, correspondence, memoranda, meeting notes, meeting minutes, working papers, graphs, charts, diagrams, notes and summaries of conversations and interviews, computer records, and any other forms of written communication, including internal NRC Staff memoranda. In your response, please identify which documents correspond to which requests below.

Pursuant to this request, please provide all documents prepared or utilized by, in the possession of, or routed through the NRC related to:


1. Records of all contacts between the Department of Energy, DOE Task Force on Commercial Nuclear Power, White House Cabinet Council Working Group headed by Mr. Healey, and the NRC regarding the operating license for the Diablo Canyon nuclear plant;
2. Briefings of DOE Secretaries Hodel or Herrington, Deputy Secretary Boggs, or other DOE officials or the compilation of "fact papers" or "data books" regarding the operating license for the Diablo Canyon nuclear plant; and
3. Records of all contacts between the Department of Energy, DOE Task Force on Commercial Nuclear Power, the White House Cabinet Council Working Group, and/or the NRC with employees or representatives of utilities, state regulatory commissions or agencies, and/or representatives of the financial community regarding the Diablo Canyon plant.

In our opinion, it is appropriate in this case for you to waive

search charges, pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552(a)(4)(A) "because furnishing the information can be considered as primarily benefiting the general public." The Nuclear Information and Resource Service is a non-profit organization serving local organizations concerned about nuclear power and providing information to the general public. Information required by 10 CFR 9.14a was provided by letter dated August 3, 1984. The San Luis Obispo Mothers for Peace is a full party to the Diablo Canyon operating license proceeding.
