

<p>Summary:</p> <p>Spoke with Mr. Flamini regarding the need to transfer all of Zurbrugg's records concerning public dose and waste disposal to the NRC prior to license termination. Mr. Flamini stated that he sits on the Radiation Safety Committee and is not aware of their having been any radiation doses to the public or any waste disposal requiring record retention.</p> <p>He will consult with the RSO and submit any required records prior to license termination.</p> <p>I stated that I would mention this telephone conversation in the cover letter to the license termination.</p> <p>Mr. Flamini mentioned that their hospital had received State of New Jersey approval to close and would be closing their doors as of September 21, 1995. I stated that I would be issuing the termination of their license on that date concurrent with the issuance of Dr. Romisher's license.</p>

This letter is to inform you that Riverside Division of Zurbrugg Memorial Hospitals, Inc. will be closing operation of our Radiology Department and as such we intend to terminate our Nuclear License. Closure of our Radiology Department is imminent as we await a letter from the New Jersey Commissioner of Health for final approval to close all inpatient care at this Riverside facility. We anticipate receiving this letter by the end of August and will close operations in Riverside approximately September 15, 1995. We will notify you when we receive official notice and hope to terminate our Nuclear License concurrent with the issuance of a new license to the Zurbrugg Outpatient Radiology Department.


