Dear Mr. Felton:

This is a request under the Freedom of Information Act, as amended (5 USC §552).

I wish to obtain the "Region III Tracking System" for dockets 454/455, in addition to any associated documentation. The "Region III Tracking System" would include reference to all I & E reports, 10 CFR part 50.55(e) reports and 10 CFR part 21 reports.

I am one of the attorneys for Business and Professional People for the Public Interest ("BPI"). We are currently involved in rate case proceedings before the Illinois Commerce Commission.

I am prepared to pay reasonable costs for reproducing the report. The Act does provide, however, that you may reduce or waive fees if it "is in the public interest because furnishing the information can be considered as primarily benefiting the public." I believe this request fits that category, and therefore ask you to waive any fees.


