Dear Dr. Kleck:

This refers to an inspection conducted on October 3, 1996, at Harper Grace Hospital in Detroit, MI. The purpose of the inspection was to determine whether activities conducted in association with the NRC reciprocity provisions of 10 CFR 150.20 were conducted in accordance with NRC requirements. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with Mr. T. Speck of your staff.
