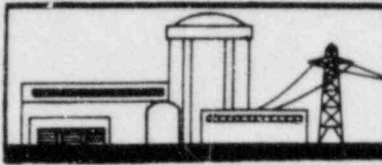

Subject: Upcoming Owners Group Actions

Dear Mr. Vissing:

The purpose of this letter is to make you aware of two recent conversations regarding upcoming interactions between the B&W Owners Group and the NRC Staff.

The next Owners Group Steering Committee meeting is scheduled for late June. Because of the status of the source term activities, we felt it would be desirable to have an NRC Staff representative attend a portion of that meeting to provide some information and an opportunity for questions and answers on the source term issue. I have spoken to Mr. Bernaro and because of his personal unavailability he suggested that Jerry Hulman participate. He is now scheduled to attend our meeting, which will be held in the B&W Bethesda Office conference room from 10:00 A.M. until 12:00 noon on June 28, 1985. We would certainly welcome your attendance during that portion of the meeting as well.

You will no doubt recall a meeting held in the B&W conference room about two months ago at which the Transient Assessment Committee discussed their future plans and activities. The committee expects to soon reach the point where two of the items they discussed in that meeting will be complete enough to make additional interactions with the Staff desirable. These two items involve revising the ARTS arming point and slightly raising the high pressure reactor trip setpoint. We believe it would be appropriate to discuss these matters in


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more detail with the Staff during the first half of August. We will pin down the date in July. We anticipate being able to provide some preliminary information to the Staff for review prior to the meeting. This should help to make the meeting more fruitful. We will work through you to set up such a meeting and would anticipate interest on the part of RSB, CPB, and ASB personnel as well as persons from the Division of Licensing.
