
Dear Mr. Crow:

Will it be possible to receive NRC's response to the report I forwarded to you about Kerr-McGee's Gore, Oklahoma plant within the next two weeks; my deadline is fast approaching.

Also, an answer the question I posed to you in the letter that accompanied my submission of the report; which is: what differences exist in the way that Allied Chemical's Uf6 plant treats and/or disposes of its waste with the way Kerr-McGee's Uf6 plant manages its waste? Does Allied's facility also incorporate disposal ponds?
