Gentlemen:

John Mathes and Associates, Inc. is hereby requesting renewal of our U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission Materials License Number 12-18760-01. Our license consists of our original license dated July 23, 1979 and Amendment Number 01 dated June 23, 1982. We have enclosed our license renewal fee of \$120.00. We are assuming, based on a recent telephone conversation with MS Pat Detloff of your office, that our existing license will remain in effect during the renewal process so long as you receive this letter prior to the date of license expiration, April 30, 1985. The remainder of this letter discusses the appropriateness of our license and any changes we wish to make.

License Renewal Comments



### Permanent Storage Location Sketch

The nuclear gauges will be stored in their shipping cases in a locked steel cabinet with key access only by licensed operators. The cabinet will be located in a room used only for equipment storage. The room has one outside access door and one interior access door. Both doors are lockable and the outside access door is kept locked at all times. This store room has no full time work requirements. The nearest area which requires full time personnel attention is a desk located in an adjoining laboratory located fifteen feet from the cabinet. The cabinet will be clearly marked with radioactive labels.
