SUBJECT: Exercise Report for the April 24-25, 1985, Exercise
of Offsite Radiological Emergency Preparedness (REP)
Plans for Arkansas Nuclear One

Attached are two copies of the Exercise Report for the April 24-25, 1985, full-participation joint exercise of the offsite REP plans for Arkansas Nuclear One. The exercise report dated June 15, 1985, was prepared by the Region VI staff of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).

There were several Category B deficiencies identified during the exercise. A schedule of corrective actions for these deficiencies has already been provided by the State of Arkansas and is contained in the exercise report. These deficiencies did not detract from the overall capability demonstrated by the State of Arkansas and Pope, Logan, Johnson, and Yell Counties to protect the health and safety of the public in the event of a radiological emergency. Therefore, the 44 CFR 350 approval granted on January 27, 1982, will remain in effect.
