Dear Ms. Bell:

This is a second partial response to your letter dated September 5, 1984, in which you requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), copies of documents pertaining to four categories of information regarding a Notice of Violation at the Catawba plant.

The documents listed on the enclosed Appendix D are responsive to your request and are being placed in the NRC Public Document Room (PDR), 1717 H Street, NW, Washington, DC 20555. You may obtain access to these records by presenting a copy of this letter to the PDR or by requesting folder FOIA-84-722 under your name.

Additional records pertaining to your request have been identified in response to a previous FOIA request. That response is maintained in the PDR in folder FOIA-84-424 under the name of Garde. You may obtain copies of these documents by referring to the above FOIA folder.

The documents listed on the enclosed Appendix E are being withheld in their entirety from public disclosure based upon the exemptions of the FOIA noted next to the descriptions of the documents.

Information withheld pursuant to Exemption (5) is predecisional in nature and contains preliminary advice, opinions, and recommendations of members of a Field Office to the Director, Office of Investigations. Disclosure would inhibit the frank and candid exchange of communications in future deliberations and thus, would not be in the public interest. There is no reasonably segregable factual information. This predecisional information is being withheld pursuant to Exemption (5) of the FOIA (5 U.S.C. 552(b)(5)) and 10 CFR 9.5(a)(5) of the Commission's regulations.

Information withheld pursuant to Exemption (7)(D) consists of the name and other identifying information of an individual who is a confidential source who provided information to the NRC during the agency's investigative effort. Because disclosure of this information would disclose the identity of a confidential source, it is being withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Exemption (7)(D) of the FOIA (5 U.S.C. 552(b)(7)(D)) and 10 CFR 9.5(a)(7)(iv) of the Commission's regulations.


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PDR FOIA
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Pursuant to 10 CFR 9.15 of the Commission's regulations, it has been determined that the information withheld is exempt from production or disclosure and that its production or disclosure is contrary to the public interest. The person responsible for this denial is Mr. Ben B. Hayes, Director, Office of Investigations.

This denial may be appealed to the Commission within 30 days from the receipt of this letter. Any such appeal must be in writing, addressed to the Secretary of the Commission, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, DC 20555, and should clearly state on the envelope and in the letter that it is an "Appeal from an Initial FOIA Decision."

The staff is continuing to review records subject to your request. We will notify you as soon as possible with regard to the remaining records.

In your response, please identify which documents correspond to which requests below.

Pursuant to this request, please provide all documents prepared or utilized by, in the possession of, or routed through the NRC related to:


1. The Notices of Violation 84-88-01 and 84-39-01 (associated with Inspection Reports 50-413-84-88 and 50-414-84-39, respectively), concerning "Inadequate Implementation of Quality Assurance Requirements in the Welding Program";
2. All "raw data" (e.g. telephone interviews, affidavits, notes), studies, and analyses done by Duke Power Company, the Brookhaven National Laboratory, and other consultants relating to investigation(s) by Duke Power Company in connection with the "Welder B" issue, and the above-referenced Notices of Violation;
3. All "raw data", studies and analyses done by or for the NRC Staff (or its consultants) for the NRC Staff's investigation of the "Welder B" issue and the above-referenced Notices of Violation; and
4. The NRC Staff review of the Duke Power investigation and documents related to the investigation.

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In our opinion, it is appropriate in this case for you to waive search charges, pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552(a)(4)(A) "because furnishing the information can be considered as primarily benefiting the general public." The Nuclear Information and Resource Service is a non-profit organization serving local organizations concerned about nuclear power and providing information to the general public. Information required by 10 CFR 9.14a was provided by letter dated August 3, 1984. The documents requested by this letter will be used by the intervenors, the Palmetto Alliance, in the Catawba operating license proceeding. Insofar as the information can lead to a full and public airing of issues related to public safety, in an adjudicatory proceeding, the release of such documents will benefit the public living near and around the Catawba plant.



Don DeMart has asked me to put together an information package for your review concerning NCI 9092 (Unit 2 Containment Dome Pitting). This binder contains a copy of the NCI, evaluation calculations, and a set of reference correspondence. I hope this is adequate for your purposes.

As Don pointed out, the inspector concerns were based mostly on the length of time required to arrive at a workable resolution. This is reflected in the Technical Evaluation for concern K-2, dated 3-22-82.

The decision was made to continue construction while the NCI was evaluated. The original description of the problem apparently did not alert design representatives to the scope of the problem. As a result, the first resolution was not made until one year after initiation of the NCI. To avoid grinding large areas of plate, an alternate resolution was made 4 months later in an attempt to define a well-faired surface. The variety of surface defects present made implementation of the second resolution difficult. The third and final resolution provided detailed inspection and acceptance standards.

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


