SUBJECT: ALLEGATION - February 7, 1984 - 11:50 a.m.

Mr. James J. Gaskill came into the RRI's Office with the following allegation.

On January 28, 1984, a mechanical/welding QC inspector was verbally harrassed over the phone and approximately one hour later - directly in front of his supervisor (Rich Booth, Senior QC Supervisor) for writing an NCR dealing with improper welding amperage by [redacted], Hanger Superintendent.

The inspector, Rick Dossett, and R. Booth-QC inspector made statements to DIC concerning this harrassment. However, no corrective action has occurred.

The individual hanger superintendent, [redacted], is still onsite with no apparent consequences.

Mr. Gaskill is concerned that no action was taken and this will lead to repeated problems.
