Pursuant to this request, please provide all documents prepared or utilized by, in the possession of, or routed through the NRC related to:


1. Records of all contacts between the Department of Energy, DOE Task Force on Commercial Nuclear Power, White House Cabinet Council Working Group headed by Mr. Healey, and the NRC regarding the operating license for the Callaway nuclear plant;
2. Briefings of DOE Secretaries Hodel or Herrington, Deputy Secretary Boggs, or other DOE officials or the compilation of "fact papers" or "data books" regarding the operating license for the Callaway nuclear plant; and
3. Records of all contacts between the Department of Energy, DOE Task Force on Commercial Nuclear Power, the White House Cabinet Council Working Group, and/or the NRC with employees or representatives of utilities, state regulatory commissions or agencies, and/or representatives of the financial community regarding the Callaway plant.
