Dear Mr. Lange:

A review of our export license files has turned up two long-standing pending export license applications that lack the necessary approval by the Executive Branch. The two cases are as follows:

XCOM1033	Equipment and systems for Power Reactor and Nuclear Fuel Development Corporation Reprocessing Plant	Japan
XCOM1034	Contactors and other equipment for Dunreay Reprocessing Plant	United Kingdom

Both applications were received in January 1990 and both were forwarded to the Executive Branch in February 1990. There has been no follow-up or inquiries into the cases since 1990; we, therefore, conclude that the exports are no longer under consideration by the Department of Energy. Accordingly, we are returning without action the above applications.
