Sgt. Sorocko asked to terminate his license but still had the source (GC, H-3) License No. 24-26109-01, Prgm #3123, Control No. 398374.

SUMMARY

1. On 3/7/96, I informed Sgt. Sorocko that he needed to dispose of the device/source to someone allowed to possess it. He agreed to try to return it to the manufacturer (Sentex).
2. On 5/9/96, He informed me that he had sent the device/source to Sentex on 5/6/96 (with a check for \$150) as registered mail w/return receipt required. (Note: repeated calls to Sgt. Sorocko did not result in him filing the necessary termination documentation).
3. 8/7/96 Note from Pat Vacherlon: Sgt. Sorocko said he sent it back a couple of weeks ago. He is waiting for confirmation from Sentex that they have received the unit.
4. On 9/6/96, I called C. Jackson of Sentex: She said Sentex didn't receive the unit.
5. On 9/6/96, after I continued to fail to have my calls returned by Sorocko, I called the Police Chief's Office. Carl Mokwa (314/444-5704) was assigned to investigate the "missing" source. He said he would call me Monday morning (9/9/96) w/results.
6. On 9/9/96, Lt. Michael Jarvis of SLMPD called to tell me that the source/device was packaged for shipment to Sentex w/return receipt required. He said that the shipment would be sent no later than 9/10/96. Sgt. Sorocko is to complete NRC Form-314 as soon as Sentex confirms receipt. I am to be contacted if Sorocko has any questions/problems filling out the form and sending it to Region III with license termination requested.

ACTION REQUIRED

St. Louis Metro Police Department needs to legally dispose of the source/device and supply documentation to us to support license termination.
