Remington Arms is the operating contractor for the Lake City Army Ammunition Plant and currently holds a Source Material License No. Sub-1195, renewal date is May 31, 1985.

The operation covered by the license has been discontinued and the facility is presently dormant. Remington has requested the Army for guidance on whether the facility will be required to supply depleted uranium penetrators in the future or if not, what the disposition of the facility will be.

We are requesting a six (6) month extension to our Source Material License No. Sub-1195 while we are seeking guidance from the Army.


