Gentlemen:

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Messrs. W. J. Slawinski and J. Mueller of this office on June 18, 1985 of activities authorized by NRC Byproduct Material License No. 12-02193-03 and to the discussion of our findings with you at the conclusion of the inspection and to the telephone conversation between you and Mr. Slawinski on June 20, 1985.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, independent measurements, and interviews with personnel.

This inspection also included a review of actions taken to correct the items of noncompliance identified during our November 3, 1981 inspection. One item identified during the previous inspection was found as a repeat item of noncompliance during this inspection (item No. 4).

During this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in noncompliance with NRC requirements, as described in the enclosed Appendix. With respect to item 3 the inspection showed that action had been taken to correct the identified noncompliance and to prevent recurrence. Consequently, no reply to this item of noncompliance is required and we have no further questions regarding this matter at this time.

Regarding the remaining items, a written response is required.

In your response to item 4, please describe why your proposed corrective action is expected to be more successful in preventing future or similar noncompliances than your action taken subsequent to our November 3, 1981 inspection.

The responses directed by this letter (and the accompanying Notice) are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.

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We will gladly discuss any questions you have concerning this inspection.
