

SHOREHAM OPPONENTS COALITION'S MOTION FOR POSTPONEMENT
OF ORAL ARGUMENT ON COMMISSION REVIEW OF ALAB-800

The Shoreham Opponents Coalition requests that the Commission postpone the holding of oral argument, now scheduled for Tuesday, June 4, 1985, regarding the Commission's review of ALAB-800. The unilateral action of the Suffolk County Executive in restraining the County's legal counsel raises important questions of law and policy that will, evidently, soon be resolved by New York state courts. It would be fundamentally unfair for the Commission to deny the people of Suffolk County their right to participate in the Shoreham proceeding during the pendency of this legal dispute.

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
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
