ORDER


On May 29 and 30, 1985, intervenors Air and Water Pollution Patrol (AWPP) and the inmates of the State Correctional Institution at Graterford, Pennsylvania, respectively, appealed the Licensing Board's May 24, 1985, order "implementing its [May 9, 1985] grant of applicant's motion for exemption." The inmates also seek a stay of the Board's order and incorporate by reference what was essentially a brief in support of the inmates' earlier, premature appeal from the May 9 Licensing Board order.

Because of the nature of the matters involved in these appeals, good cause exists for shortening the briefing period. See 10 C.F.R. § 2.711(a). AWPP's brief and that of any other party in support of these appeals is to be received by us and the other parties by close of business

(5:00 p.m.) June 12, 1985.¹ Briefs in opposition to the appeals are to be received by us and the other parties by close of business June 21, 1985.
