SUBJECT: COMPLIANCE INSPECTION REPORT

Enclosed is a compliance inspection report covering the source material activities conducted under License No. C-4327 by the Fostoria Glass Company, Moundsville, West Virginia.

The inspection report lists the following item of noncompliance:

10 CFR 20.203 Caution signs, labels, and signals

(e)(2) and (f)(2) The metal storage containers, storage cabinet, and the weighing room where the source material is stored are not posted as required.

This item was discussed with Mr. A. E. Williams, Technical Director, and a temporary exemplary sign was given to him by our representative. The sign was used to post the storage cabinet and the weighing room at that time and Mr. Williams stated that more permanent signs of the type required will be procured and used.

It is recommended that the Division of Licensing and Regulation send a letter to the Licensee requesting confirmation of the corrective action.

No follow-up inspection is planned.
