SEQUOYAH NUCLEAR PLANT (SQN) - NRC INSPECTION REPORT NOS. 50-327, 328/96-04 - ADDITIONAL INFORMATION TO THE REPLY TO NOTICE OF VIOLATIONS (NOVs) 50-327, 328/96-04

The purpose of this letter is to provide additional information to NRC relative to the contents of the original NOV response letter. On July 5, 1996, TVA submitted a letter to NRC providing a response to the subject NOVs. The cover letter stated that TVA had completed a comprehensive self-assessment of the SQN Emergency Preparedness Program (EPP) and that the minor attention to detail issues that were identified by the assessment had been corrected.

Based on a subsequent review of actions taken to resolve the EPP self-assessment, it was determined that some of the actions for the minor attention to detail issues were not fully complete when the NOV response was submitted. The review determined that some of these issues were resolved through the revision of various EPP procedures. When the violation response letter was issued, the procedure revisions had been developed and were in the approval process, for example: changes to the Nuclear Power Radiological Emergency Plan (NP REP) were reviewed and SQN concurrence was provided before the NOV response was submitted. However, the NP REP was not effective until after the NOV response was submitted. Because most of the minor attention to detail issues were already corrected and a few of the procedure changes only needed final approval, it was incorrectly considered that the actions taken were complete at the time the response letter was submitted.

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
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Currently, the actions required for resolution of the minor attention to detail items identified in the EPP self-assessment are complete and the individuals involved have been coached on the lessons learned.

This revision will not affect any of the corrective actions that TVA had accomplished or previously committed to perform.
