

We reference your letter of violation regarding the transfer of an Electron Capture Detector to C.A.L. Technologies. We were unaware at the time, that a license covered in addition to type, form and quantity, but also brand of manufacturer. Since C.A.L. Technologies was licensed for Ni-63 Electron Capture Detector and Tracor owned the Ni-63 source patent, we thought we were within the regulations.

Since your letter, we have contacted C.A.L. Technologies and have been informed they are submitting an extension of their current license to cover the Tracor detector.
