SUBJECT: FEE FOR REVISED LICENSE NO. SUA-1352

License SUA-1352 was revised on September 30, 1981, in accordance with a composite application dated January 9, 1981, filed by Cleveland Cliffs Iron Co. (CCIC). The application was filed for the purpose of incorporating into a single document the licensee's original license application and all subsequent changes or additions, as agreed to in a May 9, 1980 meeting between NMSS and CCIC. (See attached note concerning the 5/9/80 meeting).

No amendment fee was collected for the January 9 application because the Licensing staff indicated on the fee classification form that the application was filed pursuant to NRC request and the amendment was being issued for the convenience of the Commission. In a memorandum dated December 14, 1981, from Jeffrey Pohle to W. O. Miller, Mr. Pohle stated that the January 9 revised application incorporated all previously submitted licensing documents into one document, and that "This licensing action was for the conveniences of the NRC staff and is exempt from fees." Further, in a January 5, 1982 conversation with Jeffrey Pohle, NMSS Project Manager, concerning the reported 113 staff-hours of review effort for the application, Doug Weiss was informed that "the consolidated license included amendments 1 through 5" and that the staff-hours represented a "line-by-line" review comparison of the composite application with documents submitted earlier. Doug was further informed that the revised license did not contain any new authorization, but was issued for consolidation purposes only.

We agree that no fee should be charged for review of the January 9, 1981 composite application because (1) the whole purpose of the application was to combine the original license application and any additions or changes thereto into a single document, (2) NMSS requested the licensee to file the application and stated that the revised license was issued

for convenience of NRC, (3) no new authorization was granted in the revised license, and (4) the 113 staff-hours of review effort were expended for the purpose of comparing the licensee's application with previously submitted documents.
