Gentlemen:

We have received your notice that our license #SUC-628 expires July 31, 1968.

We still have on hand three hundred and twenty eight pounds of depleted uranium oxide. Several years ago we used this material as a glass colorant, but have not had any use for it since July of 1960.

We are enclosing an application for continuance of our license allowing us to store this material. We were wondering, however, if we could dispose of this 328 pounds of depleted uranium oxide by burial or some other method. If this is permissible, we wouldn't have to keep reapplying for a license for storage of this material.

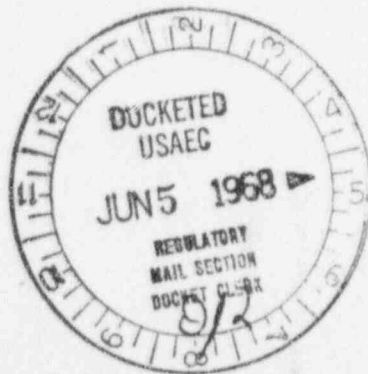
