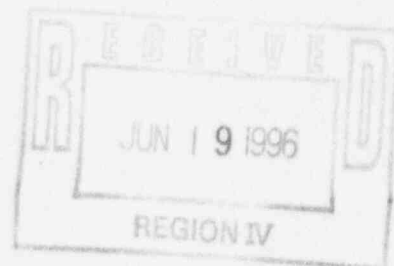

Dear Sir or Madam:

The following information is provided as a request for a license amendment to change the licensee contact and the Radiation Safety Officer. The items are numbered to correspond to Attachment 1, IN 89-25, Rev 1.

1. There is no change in the name of the licensed organization.
2. The new licensee contact is: Todd A. Schwarz, Assistant Controller  
Navajo Nation Division of Finance  
(520) 871-6337
3. Changes in personnel having control over licensed activity took place on April 25, 1995. At that time the Navajo Nation Council acting as the sole shareholder of the corporation, removed the Board of Directors and all remaining employees. At the time the only remaining employees were the General Manager, Controller, Maintenance Director, Radiation Safety Officer and Security Guard.

Until such time as a determination is made whether to reopen the mill, an interim administrative team has been designated to handle routine matters with the oversight of the Economic Development Committee of the Navajo Nation Council. In effect the Economic Development Committee is acting as the Board of Directors.

4. The mill is expected to remain closed for the foreseeable future. Cancellation of the license would require the Navajo Nation to contract for the removal and storage of the gauges which contain the licensed material. This would complicate the possible sale of the Particle Board Plant. It is the understanding of the Navajo Nation that sale of the plant would require prior licensing of the buyer if the gauges are included in the sale.
5. No sale or transfer of ownership has occurred.
6. There are currently no plans to restart operation of the facility. Sale of the plant is a possibility but not imminent.
7. There will be no change in the use, possession, location or storage of licensed material.
8. The Radiation Safety Officer will no longer be Raymond Smith. The new Radiation Safety Officer is Roscoe Smith, Security Guard. Mr. Smith has received no prior training in radiation licensing and safety issues. Vendors qualified to provide such training are being contacted. Mr. Smith will complete training by July 31, 1996.
9. As far as can be determined all surveillance items and records were current as of April 25, 1995. No tests have been conducted since that time. The Navajo Nation will be contacting vendors qualified to perform such tests and contracting for performance of such testing as is required by the license by July 31, 1996.
10. Not applicable since there is no change in licensee. Records remain at Navajo Forest Products Industries.
11. There has been no change in the status of the facility which remains closed. No contamination existed previously and none has been detected.
12. Not applicable.
13. Navajo Forest Products Industries will, under the interim management by Navajo Nation Employees, abide by all previous commitments and representations previously made to the NRC.

No transfer or sale of regulated materials or activities will take place without the prior knowledge and approval of the NRC.

14. Transfer of the responsibilities of the Radiation Safety Officer are being made with the understanding that there are no open inspection items. If any open inspection items are made known to the Navajo Nation by the NRC, appropriate remedial steps will be taken.
15. The Navajo Nation will ensure that the interim management team will abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments identified in the existing license.
