He informed me to wait for the results of the leak test, so when I responded to your letter I would have the necessary information for transfer of the gauge.


So in response to your letter dated July 30, 1996 (Control Number 398598) and received August 15, 1996, we wish to terminate our NRC License 21-12621-02.

The gauge was transferred to Testing Engineers and Consultants, NRC License 21-18668-01 as shown on the attached document. (Telephone 810 - 588 - 6200) Mr. David Bodovinac came and picked up the gauge. His license indicated he could have up to 60 gauges. This gauge made number 53. He also was carrying transport papers.

The last leak test, before transferring the gauge, was August 27, 1996. The test results are attached.
