The Atomic Energy Commission supplied documents related to Neutron Activation Analysis in the case of United States v. Stifel, 433 F.2d. 431, 436.


I would like to obtain detailed descriptions of the process of neutron activation. This information should include, if possible, schematic drawings of the actual mechanisms involved and their specific functions.

Further, I would like to obtain any documents related to the % reliability of this process in actual substance identification. Is the process still held to a valid substance identification process?
