
Dear Sir:

This letter is in response to your inquiry as to the compliance status of the Sequoyah Fuels facility located at Gore, Oklahoma.

This facility is regulated from an air pollution standpoint by both the State Air Quality Service and the Environmental Protection Agency. This facility has been inspected at a minimum of once every year since 1975. On March 13, 1984, the facility was inspected by both state and EPA personnel. The results of that inspection found the facility to be in full compliance with all applicable state and federal regulations. Over the years there have been complaints/inquiries from citizens concerning the operation of this plant. To this date, all inspections conducted by the state or EPA have shown the plant to be in compliance. The last inspection was made in October 1984.
