Dear Ms. Dean:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 56 to your NRC License No. 48-03280-01 in accordance with your request. Note that we did not authorize Dr. Eisenstein to use materials listed in Group I based on the information submitted in your letter of June 4, 1985.

In order to authorize Dr. Eisenstein to use Group I materials, you will need to submit additional information regarding Dr. Eisenstein's training and experience. Specifically, Dr. Eisenstein should have approximately 200 hours training in basic radioisotope handling techniques applicable to the use of unsealed sources. This training should consist of lectures, laboratory sessions, discussion groups, or supervised experience in a nuclear medicine laboratory (i.e., on-the-job training in a formalized training program).

In addition to the basic training, Dr. Eisenstein must also submit documentation of his supervised clinical training in an institutional nuclear medicine program (suggested 500 hours minimum). The clinical training should cover all appropriate types of diagnostic procedures (i.e., those materials/procedures listed in Group I of 10 CFR Part 35). The information submitted in your referenced letter describing Dr. Eisenstein's experience was not sufficient for Group I authorization.

Information submitted in response to this letter should state that it is additional information and not a new amendment request. If you have questions, please contact our office by dialing (312) 790-5625.
