Subject: Your letter dated September 16, 1981

Dear Mr. Weiss:

The subject letter indicates that an environmental amendment fee of \$760.00 is due in connection with Ogle's August 13, 1981 submittal of Pond Monitor Wells - Construction Details. The submittal was in response to License Condition No. 40 which states "detailed well construction specifications for each well shall be submitted to the NRC following well completion and prior to use of the evaporation pond".

Ogle Petroleum Inc. does not feel that an environmental amendment fee is required in this case and requests that the NRC reconsider its position on this matter. License Condition No. 40 simply states that certain information be forwarded to the NRC. It does not state that the submittal has to be approved by license amendment as is the case with other license conditions (e.g., License Conditions 42 and 43). Additionally, Ogle could have provided information on the well construction specifications before the license was issued if it was known that the NRC wanted the information.
