
Per our phone conversation of April 29, 1985, Morton Salt's request of January 9, 1985, requesting that our license be renewed for storage only until material can be properly disposed of, is for Item A on our license which is one sealed source Kay Ray Source Holder number 7063-P, maximum activity per source 200MCI, Source manufacturer: New England Nuclear. We are not requesting permission for storage for Item B of our license which is a sealed source Ohmart Model A-5771 not to exceed 100MCI since this equipment was never purchased. In September of 1981 Morton Salt requested an amendment to their license adding an Ohmart Model A-5771 scale. The amendment was granted, but Morton Salt never purchased the equipment.

I would also like to inform you that since the issuance of our license in 1979 the Company name has changed. Our name is now Morton Salt Division of Morton Thiokol, Inc.
