Ref: Letter from Mrs Dedik dated 27.09.96 concerning US export licence XSNM 02904/01

In the above referred letter and attachments "Euratom assurances" are requested concerning the change of an "intermediate consignee".

In our previous correspondence (our faxes to you no 6389 of 25.7.96 and to Mr McGoldrick no 6853 of 14.8.96) we have already explained that under the new Euratom/US Agreement assurances for intermediate consignees are not required and obviously eventual changes of intermediate consignees do not require any action on the Euratom side.

Furthermore this case is peculiar and worth reflecting upon since the export licence and the respective transfer of the nuclear material from the US to a facility in the UK occurred before 12.04.96. This means that, in line with article 20 of the Agreement, it is part of the initial inventory of the Agreement. It becomes for us quite unclear in the light of the new Agreement, what kind of further action Euratom could take. Obviously articles 6 (safeguards), 7 (peaceful use), 8 (nuclear fuel cycle activities) and 11 (physical protection) also apply to this nuclear material. Also in this case article 16 paragraph 2 on fungibility and article 10 paragraphs 2(a) and (b) and 3(c) are of interest.

Coming back to the referred letter, we thank you for the additional information provided and confirm that no further action is required on the Euratom side.
