Gentlemen:

Pursuant to your letter dated November 2, 1962, and the work schedule submitted in Mr. Moulden's letter dated October 31, 1962, Source Material License No. SUA-551 is hereby amended to add the following:

"For the purpose of complying with Section 20.103(b), 10 CFR 20, the limits given in Appendix B, Table I, of this part may be deemed to apply to exposures to the concentrations specified for 80 hours in any period of 14 consecutive days. In any such period where the number of hours of exposure is less than 80 hours, the limits specified in the Table may be increased proportionately. In any such period where the number of hours of exposure is greater than 80 hours, the limits specified in the Table shall be decreased proportionately."

We believe this amendment will accommodate the situation regarding shift schedules described in your letter of November 2, 1962. If you have any questions concerning this amendment, please communicate with us.
